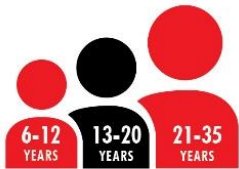

Rules and Regulations

1. See What I See - VSA Singapore's 16th Annual Art Competition 2018 ("The Competition") is open to children, youths and young adults with disabilities currently residing in Singapore.
2. The Competition is divided into 3 categories:
 - (a) **Child** (for participants born in and between 2006 and 2012) aged 6-12 years,
 - (b) **Youth** (for participants born in and between 1998 and 2005) aged 13-20 years,
 - (c) **Young Adult** (for participants born in and between 1983 and 1997) aged 21-35 years.
3. There are 8 winning entries for each category.
 - a) The voucher prizes are as follows:
 - i. 3 winners for each category: 1st prize \$350, 2nd prize \$200, 3rd prize \$100; and
 - ii. 5 merit prizes for each category: \$30;
 - b) All Winners will be offered one term of free Visual Arts lessons at VSA Singapore.
 - c) The organiser reserves the right to change or substitute the prize with another of similar value, without prior notice to the winner.
4. Entries will be judged by a panel of judges appointed by the organiser. The decision of the judges is final. No correspondence may be entered into on this subject before, during or after The Competition.
5. By submitting an entry, the entrant:
 - a) Agrees with the terms and conditions for the call and exhibition. The entrant grants permission to photography and/or to publish the artwork, artist's biography and description of the artwork for promotional and educational purposes, including broadcast, print and electronic media and the Internet;
 - b) Agrees that **all submitted entries become the property of VSA Singapore** and will not be returned to the entrants;
 - c) Understands that the organiser will take all possible care of the entries submitted, but that the organiser assumes no responsibility for any loss or damage before, during and after the competition and exhibition.
6. Selected artworks will be put on display at See What I See - VSA Singapore's Annual Art Competition Exhibition 2018 from **21st to 30th September 2018 at the Basement One Atrium of Forum the Shopping Mall**. Winners will receive their prizes at the launch of the exhibition of which the date and time will be communicated at a later time.
7. **Artwork Specification:**
 - a) Artwork MUST BE on **A3 size (42.0cm x 29.7cm)** paper. No mounting is required before submission. Framed paintings will not be accepted.
 - b) Eligible media include: paintings and drawings (oil, poster, acrylic, watercolour, pencil, pastels, charcoal, crayon, dye), and 2-dimensional mixed media on paper, i.e. collage. Canvas entries and digital images will **NOT** be admitted.
 - c) All submitted works must be original work completed in the last 6 months. They also should not have been submitted in previous competitions organised by VSA Singapore or other organisations.
8. **Submission Specification:**
 - a) Entries can be submitted on individual or pair basis.
 - i. For pair basis, a **MAXIMUM** of 2 artists per piece of work is allowed. The age category will be done according to the age of the older artist. Any prize will be divided equally between the pair.
 - ii. No more than two entries is allowed per artist and pair. Each artist/pair can win only **ONE** prize.
 - b) All entries must be labelled with the **artwork label provided within this application form. Label should be pasted at the back of each artwork**. Information should be clearly indicated on the label and must correspond with that given in the official application entry form.
 - c) All entries must be accompanied by a separate **official application entry form** (photocopies allowed).
 - d) **Incomplete forms will not be accepted**. All information is to be clearly indicated on the forms.
9. Entries must be submitted to **VSA Art Space @ Bedok at Blk 133 Bedok North Ave 3 #01-138, Singapore 460133 (open on weekdays only: Monday to Friday, 9am-6pm) by 6pm on 6th August 2018 (Monday)**.
